

Vibe Tribe's Terms & Conditions 2023 - 2024

1. Booking and Payment:

- a. To secure a booking for a dance party, a non-refundable deposit of £50 must be paid in advance.
- b. Full payment is required 2 weeks prior to the event date.
- c. Payment methods accepted include bank transfer.

2. Cancellations and Refunds:

- a. Cancellations made 14 days before the event will result in the forfeiture of the full payment.
- b. Cancellations for events & workshops made 48 hours before the event will result in forfeiture of the full payment.
- c. In the event of cancellation by the company, a full refund will be issued.

3. Event Details:

- a. Vibe Tribe must provide accurate event details, including date, time, venue, and any special requirements.
- b. Any changes to the event details must be communicated to the company in writing 14 days before the event.

4. Liability:

- a. The company is not liable for any injuries, damages, or losses incurred during the event.
- b. The client is responsible for ensuring the safety of all participants and guests during the event.

c. The client agrees to indemnify the company against any claims arising from the event.

5. Intellectual Property:

a. The company retains all rights to its choreography, music, and other intellectual property used in the workshops and performances.

b. Clients are able to record and share content from the event but must tag Vibe Tribe across social platforms.

6. Conduct:

a. The client, participants and company are expected to behave in a respectful and appropriate manner during the event.

b. The company reserves the right to terminate the event if there is any behaviour deemed inappropriate or disruptive.

7. Force Majeure:

a. The company is not liable for any failure or delay in performance due to circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of nature, government restrictions, or technical failures.

8. Photography and Videography:

a. The company may capture photographs and videos during the event for promotional purposes.

b. Participants who do not wish to be photographed or filmed must notify the company in writing before the event.
